Chamber Music Comes to South Jersey for Season Two of “Music at Bunker Hill” in Sewell, NJ

Sewell, NJ – After a successful first season, Music at Bunker Hill – a series of chamber music, vocal performances and jazz concerts – has announced its offerings for the 2009-10 season. Held at the Bunker Hill Presbyterian Church, 330 Greentree Road in Sewell, NJ, the series includes seven performances by regionally and internationally acclaimed musicians. Ticket prices range from \$20 at the door per show, to a series subscription for \$90 (adults). There are also four-show sampler series tickets and discounts for seniors and students available.

The brainchild of Sewell resident and Pennsville High School music teacher Martha Frampton and her son William, a Washington Township native and Julliard-trained violist who serves as the series’ Artistic Director, Music at Bunker Hill is doubling the number of offerings for its second season, due to positive response by the community.

Funding is made possible in part by the New Jersey State Council on the Arts/Division of State, a Partner Agency of the National Endowment for the Arts from a grant to the Gloucester County Board of Chosen Freeholders, and the Gloucester County Cultural & Heritage Commission.

- Metropolitan Opera singer **Ginger Costa-Jackson** and **Eric Downs**, Friday, February 12, 2010, 8 p.m., performing opera and Broadway classics.

Ticket prices for the 2009-2010 Music at Bunker Hill Series are as follows: season subscription (seven concerts) - \$90 for adults; \$75 for students and seniors; four-show sampler - \$60 for adults; \$44 for students and seniors.
